

Consent: True or False?

Consent should be an active choice	
If someone gave consent on a previous occasion, this can be used to assume consent on another date	
If someone gave consent to one activity, this can be used to assume consent for a similar activity	
Someone who has given consent for an activity cannot change their mind	
Consent can be given verbally or non-verbally	
If someone gives consent for an activity but doesn't fully understand the situation or the possible risks involved, this would still be considered consent	
If someone doesn't say 'no', this can be understood as consent	
The legal age of consent for sexual activity is 16	
If someone aged 15 agreed freely to sexual activity, this would be considered non-consensual	
The responsibility to ensure consent is being given fully lies solely with the person seeking consent
